BASIC PREMISE OF ANY READING

A spread (lay-out) and tarot deck and/or runes will be chosen based on the service required. If specific questions were asked, those will be addressed. Then, I will lay the cards and/or runes in the spread and interpret them based on symbology, numerology, astrology, alchemy and other methods. The interpretation will be given to the client either in writing, orally or on video.
